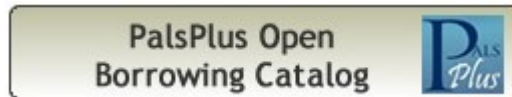
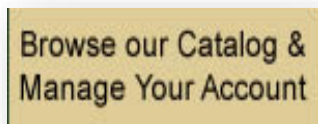


How to access free books, audiobooks, eBooks, movies, and music using your Library Card

What you'll need:

- * Your Library Card
- * Pin # (usually the last 4 digits of your home phone number)
- * A device with internet access

Ringwood Public Library is part of the PALSPlus consortium of libraries that allows borrowing between libraries. The website that acts as the online catalog can be accessed from our website www.ringwoodlibrary.org from these buttons:



Once on the PALSPlus site, you can search **physical items** (books, books on CD, music CDs, DVDs), then place holds on them. You can also review your account by clicking [My Account](#) at the top right of the screen.

Access **eBooks and audiobooks** via <https://palsplus.overdrive.com/>. Overdrive can be accessed from our website from this button:



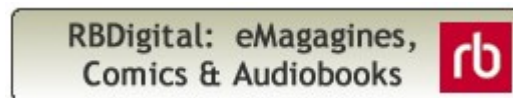
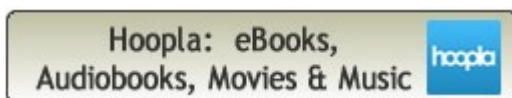
Special collections for Teens and Children on Overdrive can be found under the [Teens & Tweens](#) and [Children](#) drop-down menus on our website.

From Overdrive, you can download books to your eReader.

You can also use Overdrive's [Libby app](#), if it's available on the device you'll be using to listen or read. You can stream or download your books. Check for it in your device's App store.



You can also use your library card with [Hoopla](#) and [RB Digital](#). Hoopla provides a selection of eBooks, audiobooks, music, and movies and is compatible with smart TVs. RB Digital is great for magazines. Both can be used with a browser or an app. They are available in the iOS App Store and on Google Play. Find out more from our website using these buttons:
